There is also a phone app to take advantage of if you prefer the convenience of your phone!** Don't forget to use SCRIP with your upcoming holiday shopping! Contact the school office to sign up.

Customers who shop on **AmazonSmile** will earn 0.5% of the price of eligible AmazonSmile purchases to the charitable organizations selected by our customers.
